

## MINUTES OF 2021 ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

Held by Zoom telephone and video conference on August, 2021 7:00 – 9:00pm

#### **Proxy Votes**

Commodore appointed as proxy by 6 members – B. Cole, Y. Cole, J. Dodd, B. Lloyd, K. Robinson, D. Osinga. Secretary appointed as proxy by 1 member - C. Miller.

#### Quorum

A quorum was declared at 7:30 pm, there being 26 voting members present, plus 7 proxies appointed, for a total of 33 versus the requirement of 13 (Quorum required being 10% of the 129 financial voting members on the day).

## Minutes of September 11, 2020 AGM

Confirmation of the Minutes of the 2020 AGM was proposed by D. Wilkinson, seconded by R. Lloyd, and approved by a show of hands of those members who attended the 2020 AGM.

#### Commodore's Report – R. Lloyd

- The Commodore noted that COVID restrictions had resulted in increased complexity in all areas of running the club, and reduced hall hire income. Hall hire income for the coming year is at risk due to COVID uncertainty, and the new Committee will need to develop new income streams with COVID-safe hires, and continue stringent financial controls on spending. Maintaining a healthy relationship with Council will continue to be a priority.
- Despite COVID and the reduced sailing season the club had a successful race timetable after Christmas, and a number of successful club events.
- With greater confidence in the COVID outlook earlier this year the Committee proceeded with the planned purchase of a new engine for Seahorse and a number of other repairs.

## **Secretary's Report**

• Paid membership for the new season stands at 199, compared to 283 at the end of last season following good growth last year.



• The outlook for COVID restrictions when the present lockdown ends is uncertain. COVID check-in Marshal will likely be required for hire events, but other restrictions are uncertain.

#### Safety - M. Grant

- Following several significant safety incidents last season, the Club has presented its view of the Top 5 public hazards to Council and Parks Victoria for action.
- Members are encouraged to complete and submit incident report forms as quickly as possible to the Manager or a GC member. Safety issues should be made-safe as quickly as possible, for example by cordoning off the issue, turning off power etc.
- It was emphasised that it is important that members should not attempt to "police" the entrance gate by confronting or denying entry to members of the public insisting on access. The safety of members and staff is the priority.

#### Facilities - D. Wilkinson

- The council has completed a number of significant facility maintenance and improvements, with further actions planned.
- The club is upgrading the computer system
- Martin Burd and John Frey were thanked for their work on the flower beds!

#### Treasurer's Report - R. Lloyd

- Following the resignation in February of the appointed Treasurer B. Hamilton due to work
  pressures, that the Commodore had become Acting Treasurer. To support this action the
  accounting process was changed: the club manager prepares reconciled monthly accounts
  which are reviewed with a book-keeper to resolve any issues before preparation of the
  quarterly accounts under the supervision of the club accountant.
- Copies of the P&L and Balance Sheet for the 2020-2021 financial year were offered to all
  members by email when the meeting notice was issued, and were provided by email before
  the meeting to the 2 members who had requested them.
- The treasurer provided a summary of the P&L and Balance sheet on the prepared slides.
- Despite the COVID restrictions on operations and hall hire, the club was able to produce a relatively good financial outcome for the year through reduced general costs and significant grants and Jobkeeper:
  - o Membership and Storage income was a little higher than prior year.
  - Income from hall hire functions was significantly reduced due to COVID restrictions, partially offset by reduced function costs.
  - Grants and Jobkeeper payments provided a strong offset to reduced hall hire income, however this level of support is not continuing this year.
  - General expenses were reduced versus the prior year due to reduced club sailing operations and property related costs. The contribution of the manager, who reduced paid work hours to support the club, was noted and thanked.



- An operating profit of \$42k was achieved versus \$7K the prior year. Net profit was \$11k versus a net loss of \$25K the prior year.
- o End of year cash holdings were \$128K, up by \$33k from the previous year.
- The accountant has reviewed and supports the FY20 accounts. A formal audit is not required this year.
- At the request of the meeting the detailed P&L and Balance Sheet were also presented at the meeting. In response to questions the following points were made:
  - o In the 2020 P&L the split between Membership and Storage Fees is recognised to be inaccurate due to accounting process issues at the time. This was caused by member's payments going into RevSport, where the split between Membership and Storage fees was not recorded, and therefore had to be manually established after the fact. The manual split of fees was not correct; however the total amount of these fees is correct (\$49,574.07 + \$21,560.93 = \$71,135) and the payment total amount was checked by the accountant. A note will be added to the accounts to state this issue (Note added Aug 13, 2021).
  - The reduction in accounting fees from 2020FY to 2021FY was primarily due to higher than normal bookkeeping fees in 2020FY to help with the club's bookkeeping practices.
  - Fixtures and Fittings are 73% depreciated, and while this does not imply that there
    will need to be a plan to replace much of them within 2-3 years, there are some
    items that it may be beneficial to renew. However, given the present income hall
    hire income constraints expenditure on discretionary items will be very limited.

A motion to approve the Annual Financial Report for the year ended 30 June 2021 was moved by the by R. Lloyd, seconded by D. Wilkinson, and approved by a show of hands.

### **Motions**

- A motion to approve the election to the General Committee of five ordinary members in addition to the five officer positions was proposed by R. Lloyd, seconded by D.
   Wilkinson, and approved by a show of hands.
- There were no other motions.

#### **General Business**

No general business was discussed

#### **Appointment of the General Committee**

- The Secretary called for nominations. 10 nominations were received prior to the meeting filling all positions, and no additional nominations were received at the meeting.
- In line with the Rules, as only one member was nominated for each of the positions of Commodore, Vice-Commodore, Rear-Commodore, Secretary and Treasurer, and five members



were nominated for the five positions of ordinary committee member, the Chair declared that each of the nominated members were elected to those positions:

## Notes to the Financial Statements for the Year Ending 30 June 2021

## **Statement of Significant Accounting Policy**

## Statement of compliance

The committee has determined that the incorporated association is not a reporting entity because there are no users dependent on general purpose financial statements. The financial report is a special purpose financial report which has been prepared in order to satisfy the financial reporting requirements of the *Associations Incorporation Reform Act 2012*.

## **Basis of measurement**

The financial statements have been prepared on an accrual basis and are based on historical cost and do not take into account changing money values except where specifically stated.

The accounting policies set out below have been applied consistently to all periods presented in these financial statements.

## Property, plant and equipment

Each class of property, plant and equipment is carried at cost or fair value less, where applicable, any accumulated depreciation and impairment losses.

Plant and equipment are measured on the cost basis less depreciation and impairments losses.

The carrying amount of plant and equipment is reviewed annually by the committee members to ensure that it is not in excess of the recoverable amount from these assets. The recoverable amount is assessed on the basis of the expected net cash flows that will be received from the assets' employment and subsequent disposal. The expected net cash flows have been discounted to their present values in determining recoverable amounts.

The depreciable amount of all fixed assets, excluding freehold land is depreciated on a straightline basis over the asset's useful life to the association commencing from the time the asset is held ready to use.

The depreciation rates used for each class of depreciable asset are:

Leasehold Improvements	10%
Rescue Boats	10%
Hall Equipment	10%
Race Equipment	10%
Training Boats	10%

The assets' residual values and useful lives are reviewed, and adjusted if appropriate, at the end of each reporting period.



An asset's carrying amount is written down immediately to its recoverable amount if the asset's carrying amount is greater than its estimated recoverable amount.

Gains and losses on disposals are determined by comparing proceeds with the carrying amount. These gains and losses are recognised immediately in profit and loss.

## **Impairment**

At each reporting date the committee assesses whether there is objective evidence that a financial instrument has been impaired. If any such indication exists, the recoverable amount of the asset, being the higher of the asset's fair value less costs to sell and value in use, is compared to the asset's carrying value. Any excess of the asset's carrying value over its recoverable amount is expensed to the income statement.

#### Income tax

The association is a not-for-profit organisation and is exempt from income tax under section 50-45 of the *Income Tax Assessment Act 1997*.

### Cash and cash equivalents

Cash and cash equivalents include cash on hand, deposits, held at call with banks, other short-term highly liquid investments with original maturities cash within three months.

#### Revenue

Revenue is measured at the fair value of the consideration received or receivable. Donation income is recognised when the entity obtains control over the funds, which is generally at the time of receipt.

## Inventory

Inventory held for sale are measured at the lower of cost and net realisable value.

## Goods and services tax (GST)

Revenues, expenses, and assets are recognised net of the amount of GST, except where the amount of GST incurred is not recoverable from the Australian Taxation Office (ATO). In these circumstances the GST is recognised as part of the cost of acquisition of an asset or as part of an item of expense. Receivables and payables are stated inclusive of GST.

## Trade creditors and other payables

Trade and other payables represent the liability outstanding at the end of the reporting period for goods and services received by the company during the reporting period, which remain unpaid. The balance is recognised as a current liability with the amounts normally paid within 30 days on recognition of the liability.
